

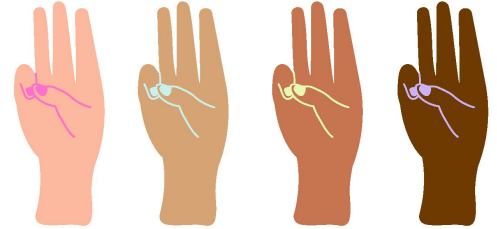
I will follow the principles of the Girl Scout Promise and Law:

The following are expected of Girl Scouts:

- I will follow the rules that are made to protect others and myself and to help make sure program activities are safe, fun and successful.
- I will treat other people, myself, property and equipment with respect.
- I will not behave in such a manner that monopolizes the time of adults and jeopardizes the Girl Scout experience for the entire group.
- I will not bully my sister Girl Scouts.
- I will listen carefully to all instructions and appropriately respond to all directions given by adults.
- I will follow the guidelines that my troop creates.
- I will not bring weapons, drugs, alcohol to Girl Scout meetings, events, campouts etc.

Failure to follow the Code of Conduct will result in one or more of the following corrective actions:

- Review of the Girl Scout Promise and Law, and written or verbal apology given, if needed.
- Meet with volunteer and caregiver to discuss behavior and create plan.
- Not following your behavioral plan may result in removal from the troop.
