





Whether it's by staying healthy, developing strong relationships with family and peers, advocating on behalf of others, protecting our environment, or exploring careers that can truly change the world for the better, girls gain the skills and the inspiration to accept challenges, overcome obstacles, and take the lead.

Life Skills Journeys

As a Girl Scout, you identify a problem you want to do something about, come up with a creative solution that will make a difference, and create a plan to make that solution a reality. Then you'll put your plan into action, talk about what you have learned, and celebrate your achievements. That's a Girl Scout Journey, and here are just a few of the areas you'll explore:

<u>Civic Engagement:</u> With a focus on preparing girls to be active and informed members of their communities, Girl Scouts offers Citizen badges for all grade levels, along with the Silver Torch and Gold Torch awards for Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors. In addition, this years new Civics badges will teach girls about their local, state, and federal government.

Community Service: Whether it's through planting a garden, painting a mural, or launching a letter-writing campaign, the It's Your World—Change It! Journey inspires Girl Scouts at every grade level to take on unique leadership and advocacy challenges and discover what it means to be a leader who makes a difference in the world.

Older Girls

Our Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador Girl Scouts have the opportunity to step into further leadership roles through the Girl Scout Highest Awards, our Girl Volunteer Corps, and so many other programs and events.

Healthy Relationships: At every stage, from Daisy to Ambassador, Girl Scouts form stronger connections with family, friends, and their communities. Younger Girl Scouts (grades K–5) make new friends as they strive to be considerate, caring, and kind. In middle school, girls learn how to cope with bullying and relational aggression. And as a Senior or Ambassador, girls will hone their people skills with their peers and their community, as they make the world a better place.

<u>Financial Literacy:</u> Grounded in real-life situations, Financial Literacy badges give girls a deeper understanding of financial issues, providing them with insight, skills, and practical knowledge in areas such as budgeting, philanthropy, making smart buying decisions, financial planning, and more.

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math)

Imagine taking on some of the biggest challenges and problems our planet faces—and helping solve them. Or having a career that is engaging and well-paid. Imaging teaming up with others to invent the future. That future can be a reality, thanks to STEM (science, technology, engineering, math).

Research shows that girls are keenly interested in STEM and <u>excel at it</u>. Yet, for a variety of reasons, girls often don't pursue STEM—starting as early as elementary school. But we can change that! See that STEM can help you make the world a better place. Girl Scouts who participate in girl-focused STEM programs:

- Become better problem-solvers, critical thinkers, and inspirational leaders
- Get better grades, earn scholarships, and follow more lucrative career paths
- See STEM as the foundation for a meaningful and successful future

Perhaps you would like to build a robot, create a popular app, invent a medical device, develop a video game, design a car, protect the world's wildlife, send a spacecraft to a far galaxy, cure a disease, keep the ocean clean, study the stars... the possibilities really are truly endless! STEM can take you where you want to go.

STEM Journeys and Badges

Automotive Engineering: Girls learn about designing, engineering, and manufacturing vehicles, as well as the future of mobility. They design their own vehicles, test prototypes, learn about design thinking, create their own assembly line manufacturing process, and more.

Engineering: Think Like an Engineer.: Girls discover how to think like an engineer by participating in hands-on design challenges and completing a Take Action project.

Computer Science: Think Like a Programmer.: Girls learn how programmers solve problems by participating in interactive computational-thinking activities and complete a Take Action project.

Outdoor STEM: Think Like a Citizen Scientist: Girls participate in interactive activities to learn how scientists solve problems using the scientific method. Girls practice observation, collect data, and complete a citizen science project. Then they create their Take Action project.

From the backyard to the backcountry, Girl Scouts has a long and storied history of getting every girl outdoors. In fact, many Girl Scouts tell us "camping trips" are one of the best things about their Girl Scout experience! It's true: connecting with the great outdoors in a girl-led setting is a big benefit of belonging to Girl Scouts.

Studies show that girls today are not spending nearly enough time outdoors. Technology and structured activities leave less time for girls to get outside and enjoy nature. But as a Girl Scout, she'll have plenty of opportunities to create her own outdoor adventures and develop a lifelong appreciation for nature and the out-of-doors—whether with her troop, at camp, or with friends and family. And that's great news—because when Girl Scouts get outside, they:

- Discover that they can better solve problems and overcome challenges
- Develop leadership skills, build social bonds, and are happier overall
- Become team players and care more about protecting our environment
- When girls spend quality time outdoors and increase their exposure to nature, they thrive physically, emotionally, and intellectually.

Outdoor Badges

In partnership with The North Face, Girl Scouts released 12 new Outdoor High-Adventure badges for all grade levels in summer 2019. These exciting new badges push girls' boundaries in the outdoors with programming ranging from trail running to rock climbing, to snow sports and hiking. Girl Scouts love high adventure!

<u>Eco Explorer:</u> Seniors become real-life ecoexplorers as they get hands-on experience with environmental issues and make a positive change in their natural surroundings. They explore biodiversity, investigate issues related to global ecosystems, research environmental topics, identify problem areas, and look into where environmental stewardship is needed most.

<u>Buddy Camper:</u> Daisies discover what adventure camping is all about! They play in nature, eat outside, and sleep under the stars as they learn about going camping—at a campsite or in a backyard—with family or friends.
