Honor Pin	<ul> <li>Recognizes an individual's exemplary service in support of delivering the GSLE, which has had measurable impact, allowing the council to reach and surpass its mission delivery goals.</li> <li>Criteria: <ul> <li>The nominee is an active, registered and background checked, member in good standing</li> <li>The service performed by the nominee is above and beyond the expectations for the position held and has made an impact on two or more regional areas within the council's jurisdiction</li> <li>Recipients must have already earned the Appreciation Pin</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	GSSOAZ Committee and Service Unit Recognition Coordinator
Volunteer of Excellence	<ul> <li>Recognizes volunteers who have contributed outstanding service while collaborating directly with girls in any pathway to implement the GSLE through the use of the National Program Portfolio or in support of the council's mission delivery to girls and adult members.</li> <li>Criteria: <ul> <li>The nominee is an active, registered and background checked, member in good standing</li> <li>The nominee has performed beyond expectations for the position to deliver the GSLE to girls using the National Program Portfolio OR the nominee has performed beyond expectations of the position and has supported the council's mission delivery goals in one or more of the following functional areas: Membership Development, Community Cultivation, Volunteer Relations and Support, Programs, Leadership and Governance, Fund Development and Council Support Service, -(such as IT Customer Service, Product Program Sales, etc)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	GSSOAZ Committee and Service Unit Recognition Coordinator
