Girls can do one activity (or all!) to learn about how to take action and address a community problem!



1. Get the Word Out on Social Change
2. Assess the needs of the community
3. Plan a social change project
4. Implement a social change project
5. Write thank you notes

More great activities to get girls thinking about social change:

- Journal about an issue in the world or your community you want to change.
- Write a letter to the leader of a corporation, a government official, or one of your local representatives about a positive change you want them to make. Check this story out about [Meghan Markle](#) as inspiration!
- Write a poem, song, or story about what your ideal world looks like.
- Send someone a letter thanking them for being a good role model.
- Create a vision board or magazine collage of words or images that encompass the kind of leader or friend you want to be.
- Plan a list of habits people could take on to help an issue you see in the community. Share with your family and ask them to adopt one or two habits along with you.
