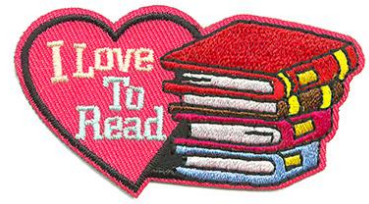


## I Love to Read Week

Girls of all levels can earn the *I Love to Read* fun patch by trying out fun new ways to read at home, and spreading their love of reading! Try reading outdoors, experiment with different reading spots and types of reading materials, or bring your favorite stories to life at home.



Read on for fun ways to love reading! You can do one activity, or you can do them all.

- I Love Reading BINGO
- ABC Scavenger Hunt
  - Find a book, character, or plot for each letter of the alphabet
  - Find a picture on your phone for each letter of the alphabet
  - Create an ABC book, and draw your own picture for each letter of the alphabet
- Write or record a book review to share with friends
- Interview an older family member or friend. Ask them about their favorite books from their childhood.
- Find a movie that's based on the book. Read the book, and watch the movie. Compare and contrast. Which one do you like better?
- Make your own book mark. Get creative!
  - Bonus: Make bookmarks to share with your friends and family!
- Start a virtual book club
- Family Dinner theme: dress up as your favorite book character
- Play charades
  - Using stories and books your family loves, write characters (or book titles) on slips of paper, put them in a bowl, and take turns acting them out for others to guess!
    - Get started: Mickey Mouse, Cat in the Hat, Harry Potter, If you Give a Mouse a Cookie.
- Create a treat from a story you love (Green Eggs & Ham, anyone?)
- Go through your books, and donate books you no longer read to a local school or shelter (when it's safe!)
