

The President's Volunteer Service Award





Presidential recognition sets you apart from your peers. It is a tremendous honor and we at GSSOAZ are proud to be a certifying organization for the President's Volunteer Service Award.

The President's Volunteer Service Award recognizes United States citizens and lawfully admitted, permanent residents of the United States who have achieved the required number of hours of service during a specified time frame.

### **Eligibility:**

Hours are measured over a 12-month period and awards are designated based on cumulative hours. The awards are offered in multiple levels and are designed to recognize each milestone of your service achievement. Levels include Bronze, Silver and Gold.

### Criteria:

Registered Girl Scout individuals, families and groups that meet the criteria are eligible to earn the President's Volunteer Service Award.

- Recipients must be a United States citizen or a lawfully admitted permanent resident
- Awards are issues for service hours served within a 12-month time frame, set by GSSOAZ
- Awards are issued for volunteer service only
- Individuals must be at least 5 years old
- Awards are issued by GSSOAZ, an approved certifying organization
- Submitted hours must be approved by GSSOAZ

## **Eligible Service DOES NOT include:**

- Donating funds
- Political lobbying, non-partisan voter registration is an eligible activity
- Religious instruction
- Conducting worship service
- Proselytizing
- Volunteer service performed as part of a court-ordered community service
- Serving only family members
