## Why were the two events combined?

#### Why is it \$30 to attend the Cookie Rally?

This year, we've combined several events—a 2.2-mile color run, Cookie Rally, Vendor Expo, Winter Market, Dance Party, and more—into one! In the past, you'd pay \$15 for rally swag or \$45 for the run alone. This year, you get everything for just \$30! It's packed with fun, activities, and extra swag!

# What's so special about this compared to rallies in the past?

It's BIGGER and better! We've got tents dedicated to the 5 Girl Scout business skills (including one for caregivers!), hands-on fun instead of paper crafts, and outside vendors bringing even more excitement. PLUS, a DJ dance party, food vendors, face painting, bubbles, balloons, donuts, coffee, make-your-own trail mix, cookie tastings, and so much more! This is an experience you don't want to miss!

#### What is the length of the event?

9:30- coffee and donuts, zumba and stretching. 9:45am - step off for timed run. 10am - step off for fun run (in heats) 10:30-12:45 Rally, Market, Vendors. 1pm event ends. It's come and go though so if you do the run, visit everyone and you feel you've "done it all" you definitely do not have to stay till 1. Just like when you go to the fair, enjoy in the time span that fills your heart.

Our towns Electric Light Parade is this same night! Fantastic what a fun full day for you and your Girl Scouts! Even for those having the furthest to drive you can still get back to your parade and have a day that's fun and full.

## What do we get for our \$30 registration?

Your registration covers everything: entry to the event, SWAG, the run, morning treats, vendor giveaways, face painting, inflatable fun, and so much more! The only thing not included are food trucks or items for sale like at the Winter Market.

## Is this a good use of troop funds?

You bet it is! It's the perfect troop outing—packed with fun, programming, memories, and laughter. What better way to bond with your troop?

## When is packet pick-up for us to get all our goodies?

Pick up your packet on December 4th from 12-4 PM at our local offices. You'll get your T-shirt, race bib, sunglasses, backpack, patch, and more!

## What if we can't make it to packet pick-up?

No worries! You can grab your items onsite the day of the event, from 8:30 AM - 10 AM.

## How will you know if I've paid for registration if we just walk into Kino the day of the event?

Your T-shirt and race bib are your tickets into the event. Be sure to wear them (or at least your race bib) somewhere visible on the day of the event even if you do not plan on participating in the color run - that's the visual for security.

# What about the Winter Market? We're usually vendors—do we have to pay to attend?

Nope! Just fill out the Winter Market sign-up form and host your booth. If you're a Girl Scout hosting, we'll close the Winter Market at noon, so you'll still have time to enjoy all the Cookie Rally programming and vendor fun.
